This in-district assessment is only done for these high school dual enrollment students. High school dual enrollment students whose tuition is not being paid by the school district have their tuition rate determined normally. Early College Programs are charged in-district tuition rates. OCC's actual in-district tuition rate for 2021-2022 was \$99.00, and the outof-district tuition rate was \$192.00.
