Following the performance, the audience will be invited backstage for a hands-on experience with the beautifully handcrafted puppets. Yung Shing Le is a century-old family theater troupe which keeps traditional practices and stories alive while infusing modern techniques and original stories to stay relevant to today's audiences.
