



Certified Registered Central Service Technician (CRCST)

The CRCST program is designed to give entry-level and incumbent healthcare workers the experience, knowledge, and skills necessary to become certified as a Central Service Process Technician, also known as a Sterile Process Technician. Central Service Process Technicians are responsible for decontaminating, inspecting, assembling, packaging and sterilizing reusable surgical instruments or devices in a healthcare facility. Following completion of this course, individuals will have the classroom knowledge required to take the IAHCSSM (International Association of Healthcare Central Service Materiel Management) Certification Exam. In addition to the classroom hours, the IAHCSSM certification process will also require four hundred laboratory hours in a central service processing department. The four hundred lab hours must be completed within six months of passing the exam, if not obtained previously.
