We have received your financial aid application materials and cannot continue processing until a "credits attempted" problem is resolved. When calculating maximum eligibility for financial aid, OCC must count all attempted credits from OCC and previous colleges attended.

Your grade transcript at OCC shows that you are close to or have exceeded the maximum credits allowed for your program. Maximum eligibility is 150 percent of the published length of your program as measured in credit hours. (Example: Liberal Arts: 62 credit hours x 150% = 93 credit hours).

Make an appointment with an OCC counselor (this cannot be done on a walk-in basis) to have the FAAP – Max completed. Submit the completed plan to your campus Student Financial Resources and Scholarship (SFRS) and you will be given a copy. Processing will then resume and you will be notified by email.

Students on the FAAP – Max may enroll for only classes listed below. Any classes for which you register that are not listed on this plan will result in financial aid being cancelled for all classes. NO EXCEPTIONS!
